Income Eligibility Guidelines

Income eligibility for fuel assistance, free weatherization, and other low-income benefits can be assumed if the unit's bill payer meets at least one of these criteria:

- 1. Discounted electric and/or gas rates with National Grid
- 2. Are a SNAP Recipient
- 3. Receives Fuel Assistance

It is also possible to qualify for discounted electric and/or gas rates with National Grid if your bills are in your name and you are currently receiving:

SSI, WIC, TAFDC, EAEDC, School Breakfast Program, Head Start, MassHealth (Medicaid), Public Housing, National School Lunch Program, Veterans' Service enefits (Chapter 115), Veterans DIC Surviving Parent/Spouse, Veterans Non-Service Disability Pension.
